- 8. All entries will become the property of RISPLS, Inc., and will be disposed of after award presentation.

<u>Judging</u>

All entries will be checked for compliance with the Procedural and Technical Standards for the Practice of Land Surveying in the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations as adopted by the Board of Registration. No plan will be judged if it does not comply with said Standards.

- Overall appearance, neatness, balance and consistency.
- Lettering clear and unmistakable.
- Completeness (deed reference, plan references, areas, old property lines, monuments, etc)
- Qualifying notes or statements (clearly and unmistakably stated) Signatures and seals.

Plan Categories (Property Line, Subdivision, Site Plan) will be judged using either mechanical or freehand methods.
