# DSB Mission & Board - MGL Chapter 7C

The DSB is an independent agency under A&F and was established as an autonomous 11-person board to ensure complete compliance with the intent and spirit of Designer Selection Law and related statutes.

- Ensure that Commonwealth obtains the most qualified designer for each of its building projects.
- Maintain public confidence in designer selections.
- **Provide consistency** in design service procurement methods.
- Encourage broad-based participation in public design work.
- **Provide safeguards** to maintain the integrity of the system of procuring design services.



#### Appointed by the Governor

- Three (3) registered Architects one opening
- Three (3) registered Engineers one upcoming opening
- Two (2) representatives of the Public who are not registered architects, engineers, or licensed contractors – one opening

#### Appointed by the building-related professional societies

- A registered Architect by the American Institute of Architects
- A registered Engineer by ACEC-MA
- A general contractor by the Associated General Contractors



# The Players and the Projects

- The DSB has oversite of the process for Designer Selection when the design fee exceeds \$30,000 or total project cost exceeds \$300,000.
- For all agencies across the commonwealth some have exemptions to have their own Selection Committee, such as EOHLC.
- Project Types:
  - Capital Projects (New Construction, Major Renovations)
  - House Doctor Project ( < \$5 Million ECC unless approved for up to \$10M by DCAMM)
- DSB employs the Designer Selection Network Portal for designer registration and disclosure, project application, and designer evaluation processes
- DSB meetings approximately every 2 weeks online, open to the public per the Public Meeting Law

#### **DSB Roles**

- Manage "Designer Selection Network" web portal
- Post Public Notices in the Central Register and in the DSN
- Applications received in the DSN must be registered
- Board reviews Applications and shortlist Ranked/Unranked
- Schedule and oversee interview process
- Select Designer(s)
- Reviews and publish designer evaluations
- Works with Charter Schools to develop scope and draft Designer Selection Public Notices for the above process

#### **DCAMM Roles**

- Work with user agency to clarify project scope
- Assist in drafting the Designer Selection Public Notice (DSB-Ad)
- Interface with DSB administrative staff
- Provide comments on applications
- Attend interviews and answer RFP related questions.
- Issue appointment letters to selected design firm(s)
- Prepares contracts and collects affidavits on MBE/WBE/VBE/SDOVBE



#### **QBS Selection**

Competitive procurement process with Qualification-Based Selection. Firms are first qualified, and sometimes ranked, according to their qualifications without regard to design fees. The types of qualifications include:

- Project type experience
- Proactive work in sustainability, resiliency, healthy building environments, & Accessibility
- Equity and inclusion of diverse voices through firm objectives, partnering, and selection of subconsultants
- Knowledge of Ch. 149 or 149A
- Other criteria as noted in the Public Notice

# Registration and Disclosure for Prime and Subconsultants

# **Disclosure Statement in the Designer Selection Network containing :**

- Certification that the applicant is a legal entity and is a designer, interior designer or construction manager as defined in subsection (b) of section 44;
- The names and addresses of all partners, if a partnership, or of all officers, directors and all persons with an ownership interest of more than 5 per cent if the applicant if not a partnership;
- The registration number and status of each such person in every jurisdiction in which such person has ever been registered as an architect, landscape architect or engineer;
- A list of all projects for all public agencies within the Commonwealth for which the applicant has performed or has entered into a contract to perform design services within the 5year period immediately preceding the filing of the information required in this section;
- A list of all current projects for which the applicant is performing or is under contract to perform any design services; and
- If the applicant is a joint venture, the information required in this section shall be required for each joint venturer, as well as for the joint venture itself.
