NSPS Updates

NSPS Announces Guidelines for 2018 Awards Program

NSPS recently announced their guidelines and criteria for their 2018 awards program. All NSPS members are encouraged to participate by nominating themselves or their peers in the categories for which they are eligible by the April 30, 2018 deadline. The categories of awards include: Surveying Excellence for members who have made an outstanding contribution to the surveying profession; Earle J. Fennell Award for distinguished educational contributions to the surveying and mapping profession; Map/Plat Design Competition of freehand and machine or computer drafted maps and plats completed after June 30, 2016; Student Project of the Year for projects done by undergraduate students enrolled in a surveying or related program.
