Please Participate in the National Geodetic Survey's GNSS Data Collection Project

The National Geodetic Survey (NGS) is actively improving the accuracy of its hybrid geoid model and will replace GEOID12B with GEOID18 in early 2019. This new hybrid geoid model will improve the derivation of orthometric heights (elevations) referenced to the North American Vertical Datum of 1988 (NAVD 88) using Global Navigation Satellite System (GNSS) technology. The new model will also thereafter serve as the official means for obtaining NAVD 88 heights via GNSS.

NGS will use GNSS data collected on bench marks to create the new hybrid geoid model. Recent analyses have revealed 25 areas in Massachusetts where the collection and submission of additional GNSS data will improve the geoid model by either confirming or updating the relationships between ellipsoid, orthometric, and geoid heights. Twenty of the identified areas have had data collected. Interested MALSCE members are asked to participate in this project by occupying with GNSS one or more of the five remaining identified bench marks and sharing the collected GNSS data with NGS. MALSCE Education Trust Is Now Accepting Scholarship Applications

The MALSCE Education Trust was founded to enhance the profession of land surveying and civil engineering in Massachusetts by providing scholarship and education grants for the students of land surveying and civil engineering who are Massachusetts residents. The Trust is currently accepting applications for three scholarships, detailed below.

The *Survey Certificate Program Scholarship* is awarded to students currently enrolled in an accredited Land Surveying Certificate Program.

The *Memorial Scholarships* are awarded to students presently enrolled full time (days) as an undergraduate in an accredited college, university, junior college, technical institute or community college and majoring in land surveying, civil engineering, or environmental engineering.

The UMaine Scholarship is awarded to a Massachusetts resident who is an incoming freshman (or transfer student) enrolled in the University of Maine Surveying Engineering Technology program (SET/SVT).
