A. Richard Vannozi, MS, PLS, University of Maine

Richard has taught surveying across New England since 2003. Currently, he teaches at The University of Maine in the Surveying Engineering Technology program, where he teaches courses across the curriculum, both in the traditional classroom and on-line. Rich is registered as a professional land surveyor in Massachusetts and has been since 1988. He is a former president of MALSCCE and, in 1998, was recognized as MALSCCE's Surveyor of the Year. He currently serves on the NSPS Education Committee and is the advisor to the NSPS Student Chapter at the University of Maine. Rich maintains a small consulting practice that specializes in complex boundary, title, and zoning matters for select clients including attorneys and other professional land surveyors.
