Connecticut Association of Land Surveyors Annual MAP DESIGN COMPETITION November 4, 2016 - Contest Rules

1. Map Design Contest is open to ALL CALS Members. <u>Preparer/drafter AND certifying surveyor must both be</u> <u>CALS Members.</u>

2. ALL entries must be received at the CALS office no later than Wednesday, October 26, 2016.

3. ALL entries must bear an original date of no earlier than October 31, 2015, the date of last year's annual meeting. Revision dates to map bearing original date earlier than October 31, 2015, are not acceptable.

4. ALL entries must be prepared using: The Regulations of State agencies, sections 20-300b-1 through 20-300b-20. (This includes Presentation Drawings.) "The specific survey type or types MUST be stated in the title. "Property/Boundary Survey" or "Limited Property/Boundary Survey" are NOT survey types. "Resurvey", "Dependent Resurvey", "Original Survey" or "First Survey" also are NOT survey types but Boundary Determination Categories. Any map not meeting these few basic requirements will not be judged nor put on display."

5. Entries shall consist of unmounted blue or black line prints/plots being standard size (24" x 36", 18" x 24" or 12" x 18") except for Presentation Drawings (which shall be no larger than 36" x 48" and may be in color) and Boundary Stake-Out Sketches which may be on 8-1/2" x 11" or 11" x 17" sheets.

6. Entries may be either hand drawn or produced by mechanical means.

7. All entries must be accompanied by an official entry form, and should not be folded.

8. Entries are limited to two (2) per category. Firms are allowed to enter plans in the same category by different drafters.

9. Decisions of the judges are final. Any ties in the judges scores will be broken by the committee chairperson's vote.

10. All maps <u>meeting the minimum eligibility requirements (see 4 above)</u> will be mounted and displayed and the winners will be announced at the annual meeting.

11. It shall be the responsibility of the "Best in Competition" winner to forward their entry to the National Competition if they so choose. CALS will pay the registration fee. <u>All maps must be signed and sealed</u>.

JUDGING STANDARDS

1. Conformance with "Standards"

Conformance with the "Standards for Surveys and Maps in the State of Connecticut", adopted by **CALS** on September 26, 1996 (Sections 20-300b-1 through 20-300b-20 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies) <u>no others accepted</u>. "For example, the specific survey type or types MUST be stated in the title. "Property/Boundary Survey" or "Limited Property/Boundary Survey" are NOT survey types. "Resurvey", "Dependent Resurvey", "Original Survey" or "First Survey" also are NOT survey types but Boundary Determination Categories."

2. Content

- A. Clear interpretation of what map is intended to depict.
- B. Technical aspects Accuracy levels, attention to detail, monumention quality, etc.

3. Aesthetic Quality

- A. Neatness
- B. Layout
- C. Proportional scale to plan size
- D. Artistic influence and originality (line weighing strategy, font/text style variations, symbology, etc.)


