The ACEC/MA Community Service Award recognizes employees of ACEC/MA member firms
Nominations Due: February 2, 2024, 5 PM

This award will recognize employees of ACEC/MA member firms who have made outstanding contributions to the quality of life in the community. This award is open to all current and retired members of ACEC/MA, excluding those currently serving on the ACEC/MA Board of Directors and/or the ACEC National Committee of Fellows.

The winner of the Community Service Award will be recognized at the ACEC/MA Engineering Excellence Awards Gala on March 28, 2024, in Boston. The winner will be forwarded to ACEC National for consideration in their competition. The national award winner will be recognized at the ACEC 2024 Fall Conference.

The ACEC/MA Community Service Award recognizes employees of ACEC/MA member firms for their accomplishments in community service.

- Nominations:** Any Member (current or retired) or Fellow of ACEC/MA is eligible to apply, excluding those currently serving on the ACEC/MA Board of Directors and/or the ACEC National Committee of Fellows. If your firm is an ACEC/MA member, you are an ACEC/MA member.
 - Nominations are due to ACEC/MA by C.O.B on Friday, February 2, 2024, and submitted electronically to acecma@engineers.org
 - All nominations must be complete and submitted electronically on the nomination form provided.
- Evaluation and Selection of Nominees:** The evaluation of the nominees for the award will be made by the Awards Committee. Final selection will be made by the ACEC/MA Board of Directors.
- Criteria for Award:**
 - The nominees shall be outstanding individuals who have been involved in community service such as board, commissions or community groups and shall have demonstrated a sustained commitment to their communities.*
 - The nominees shall be perceived by the public in their communities as leaders. The nominees may have been active in local, county or state government.
 - The nominees shall have served to influence decision-making on issues other than professional.
 - The nominees may demonstrate, through their civic involvement, how the quality of life in their community has been enhanced.
 - The nominees shall have received no remuneration for professional services rendered, if any.
 - The nominees shall be or have been a principal or manager in a member firm of ACEC/MA for at least five (5) years.
- Recognition:** Winners will be recognized at the ACEC/MA Engineering Excellence Awards Gala on March 28, 2024 in Boston. National Winners will be recognized in person at ACEC's Fall Conference.
