Massachusetts Senate Agrees To Plan Reshaping Its

**40 Districts:** State senators approved new maps for their

districts on a 36-3 vote on 10/27, with two of those who voted in opposition raising concerns about both their individual districts and the process behind the changes. The Senate's redistricting plan doubles the number of districts where a majority of residents are non-white -- from three to six, out of 40 -- and reduces the number of municipalities split among multiple districts.

Late US Census data this year put lawmakers on a condensed timeline for redrawing their districts; a process that normally takes about half a year was done in less than two months this cycle.

On 10/21, the Senate also passed a bill redrawing the 160 House of Representatives district boundaries, which the House green-lit last week on a 158-1 vote. The House will similarly need to vote on the Senate's maps.
