Similarities, But Big Differences In House, Senate ARPA Bills: On 11/3/21, the Massachusetts Senate Ways & Means released its version of the ARPA Bill.

Amendments will be due by 3 PM on Friday, though that might be extended to 11/8. Debate is planned to begin on 11/10.

Last week, ACEC/MA and coalition partners from MWWA and UCANE advocated for an increase in water infrastructure funding. While the House did not adopt one one specific amendment, environment and climate spending represents another sizable chunk of the House version of the ARPA bill with more than \$400M total following the adoption of a mega-amendment.
