

DOE plans to release two carbon capture funding announcements in late February 2023.

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) announced on 2/8/23 a funding opportunity of up to \$74M for up to

seven pilot projects that will test the efficacy and scalability of enhanced geothermal systems (EGS). Directed by the landmark Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), the pilot projects will use innovative technology and a variety of development techniques to capture the Earth's abundant heat resources in diverse geologic settings. Through this investment, DOE hopes the research and development from the findings would demonstrate the growth and ultimate potential for geothermal energy to provide reliable, aroundthe-clock electricity to tens of millions of homes across the country. This is DOE's first funding opportunity for geothermal energy since the launch of the Enhanced Geothermal ShotTM, part of DOE's Energy EarthShots Initiative, which seeks to cut the cost of geothermal energy
