2024 National Compensation Matrix (NCM) is Now Available

The 2024 NCM is used by state DOTs for evaluating 2023 executive compensation.

AASHTO's Committee on Internal and External Audit applied an escalation factor in developing the 2024 NCM, so you will not see any NCM compensation limits that decreased, as we saw in the 2023 NCM. For firms / positions where it is relevant, the Bipartisan Budget Act (BBA) compensation limit increased to \$619,000 for evaluation of 2023 compensation.

This tool applies to CY2023 data. To use, enter actual revenues from A/E consulting engineering services to compute compensation amounts.
