Earlier this week, during an ACEC/MA and MassDOT Partnering Meeting, MassDOT emphasized that they expect designers to submit design schedules monthly (for all funded projects) to the MassDOT Project Manager in both Microsoft Project and in PDF formats. Consultants should use this format for naming both files:

XXXXXXMUNICIPALITYMMYYYY where XXXXXX is the PINFO number.

In addition, consultants should submit a narrative addressing major issues and concerns as well as an explanation of any impacts to the project monthly with the Progress Schedule. For each division of work, the narrative should address:

- 1. The status of each major deliverable
- 2. Work performed during dates of service
- 3. Issues/proposed solutions
- 4. Significant meetings/events
- 5. Outstanding issues and critical actions required by the

Designer, MassDOT, or third parties.

### DOER Releases Draft Stretch Energy Code Regulations

The Massachusetts Department of Energy Resources (DOER) released draft code language for its Stretch Energy Code and Specialized Municipal Opt-in Code on June 24:

DOER filed these Draft Regulations with the Secretary of State on June 24 and will provide an overview of the newest draft code language and respond to frequently asked questions during a <u>recorded webinar planned for</u> <u>7/7/2022</u>. In addition to 3 public hearings this summer, DOER is accepting public comment until August 12 at 5 PM. You'll find <u>additional important information here</u>.

The Baker administration expects that its stretch energy code and specialized municipal opt-in code will save an estimated 500,000 tons of greenhouse gas emissions in 2030 with "no-to-minimal costs" to new construction, and \$21B in construction and operating lifecycle costs. DOER said the draft regulations it filed with the secretary of state's office Friday are generally "very consistent" with the straw proposal the department released in February.
