ACEC Updates on PPP Loans / FAR Credits Clause Issue

ACEC is launching a **new grassroots campaign** to push federal lawmakers to protect engineering firms that received forgiven PPP loans from problems stemming from the FAR credits clause. ACEC is making progress – the House of Representatives has approved an amendment to provide partial relief – but more ACEC member engagement is needed to bolster the case for a waiver to allow firms to keep their PPP loans.

ACEC is asking Congress to include a legislative fix in the infrastructure package currently under consideration to ensure that all firms qualifying for forgiven PPP loans may be allowed to keep this critical assistance.

We also won a partial fix to the PPP/FAR credits clause issue in the bill, limiting the FAR credit to federal dollars in contract payments and thereby preventing state DOTs from applying the FAR provision to state-funded contracts.
