The Massachusetts Legislature plans to end its formal session on July 31, 2022. Several major bills are in conference committees so that the House and Senate can work on compromise bills to send to the Governor's desk.

Several other major bills are still working their way through either the House or the Senate, with a conference committee needed to work out any differences.

Here are bills sent to the Governor in the past week:

- FY2023 Budget: More Info >
- COVID-19 Policy Extensions: Chapter 107 of the Acts of 2022, passed by legislature and signed by Governor Baker: This new law extends some pandemic-era policies that were set to lapse on July 15, 2022 and will now remain in place through March 31, 2023.

Major Bills of Interest to ACEC/MA Members in conference committees or soon to be in one:

- Conference Committee Report expected by 7/21 on Energy & Climate: H 4524 and S 2842 More Info >
- <u>Senate Unveils \$4.3 Billion Economic Development</u>
 Bill
- The Massachusetts House and Senate sent the \$10.4B infrastructure bond bill to conference committee on July 18; late on July 20, legislators indicated that they appear to be close to final deal, so we may see the final bill on July 21, when both the House and Senate are scheduled for formal sessions. Bills are: H 4916 and S 3016. This infrastructure bond bill is important for the state to allocate the state match for the federal IIJA (Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act) as well as to have additional funding to apply for some competitive federal infrastructure grants. In addition, both versions of the bill include our Dig Safe language, a direct result of our grassroots advocacy work. We are working to keep this in the conference report for this bill.
