- \$400M for Immediate Safety Improvements for MBTA
- \$2.8B for interstate and non-interstate federal highway system
- \$1.375B for transit and rail improvements
- \$1.27B for non-federally aided road and bridge projects and tens of millions of dollars more for multimodal transportation planning, regional transit network improvements and Complete Streets funding for municipalities.
- ACEC/MA-backed Dig Safe Language now law
- ACEC/MA in in Governor's amendment on Mobility Pricing Commission

Governor Baker approved all of the bond authorizations in the nearly \$11.4B bill (was H. 5151) he signed on 8/10/22, including \$400M for immediate safety improvements at the MBTA and \$275M as a down payment toward a western Massachusetts passenger rail expansion, and several of the outside sections packed into the major legislation

Another Baker amendment to this bill would expand a proposed mobility pricing commission, which lawmakers tasked with studying and making recommendations on measures such as congestion pricing and public transit fares, by eight members. The new seats would be filled by representatives of AAA, Construction Industries of Massachusetts, American Council of Engineering **Companies**, Trucking Association of Massachusetts, Retailers Association of Massachusetts, Massachusetts Restaurant Association, Massachusetts Health and Hospital Association and the hospitality industry. At press time, this law does not yet have a session chapter number.
