
CONSENT AGREEMENT


The Massachusetts Board of Registration of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors and Mark Casey ("Respondent"), do hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into and become a permanent part of the Respondent's record maintained by the Board:

1. The Respondent agrees that this Consent Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into in resolution of the Board's investigation of a complaint filed against him, Investigative Intake Record No.2021-001027-IT-ENF, and the Order to Show Cause issued pursuant thereto.
2. The Respondent hereby acknowledges and admits that if the present matter proceeded to a hearing before the Board it could be found that his company, South Shore Survey Consultants, Inc., violated G.L. c. 112 s. 65A for offering land surveying services without complying with the business entity requirements 250 CMR 5.05. The respondent states that any such violation was inadvertent, and that the company has since installed a licensed land surveyor as an officer in the corporation to be the Registrant-in-charge.
3. Whereby, in an effort to resolve the matter amicably and without the need for a formal hearing before the Board, the Respondent agrees to pay a CIVIL ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00). Said amount shall be in the form of a bank cashier's check or money order payable to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and shall be delivered with a signed copy of this Consent Agreement to Prosecuting Counsel Seth Henderson, Office of Prosecutions, Division of Occupational Licensure, 1000 Washington Street, Suite 710, Boston, Massachusetts 02118.
4. The Respondent agrees to comply with all requirements contained in this Consent Agreement, all state and federal laws, and all laws and regulations governing the engineering and land surveying profession in the Commonwealth.
5. The Board agrees that in return for the Respondent's execution of this Agreement, it will not further prosecute the allegations arising from its investigation of Investigative Intake Record No.2021-001027-IT-ENF and the Order to Show Cause issued pursuant thereto.
6. The Respondent understands and agrees that entering into this Agreement is a final act, which is not subject to reconsideration, appeal, or judicial review.

7. The Respondent states that he has used legal counsel in connection with his decision to enter into this Agreement or, if he has not used legal counsel, that the decision not to do so has been one taken of his own free will.
8. The Respondent understands and agrees that after its Effective Date, the Agreement constitutes a public record and that the Board may forward a copy of this Agreement to other licensing boards and/or law enforcement entities, as well as to any other individual or entity as required by law.
9. The Respondent certifies that he has read this document entitled "Consent Agreement." He understands that he has a right to formal adjudication concerning the allegations against him and that during said adjudication he would possess the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses, to call witnesses, to present evidence, to testify on his own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, to appeal to the courts, and all other rights as set forth in the Massachusetts Administrative Procedures Act, G. L. c. 30A, and the Standard Adjudicatory Rules of Practice and Procedure, 801 CMR 1.01 *et seq.* The Respondent further agrees that in executing this document entitled "Consent Agreement," he is knowingly and voluntarily waiving his right to a formal adjudication of the above-referenced complaint and to all of the related rights listed above.
10. The Respondent understands that this Agreement will not be effective until the Board formally approves it, and the "Effective Date" of this Agreement shall be the date it is signed by the Board.
