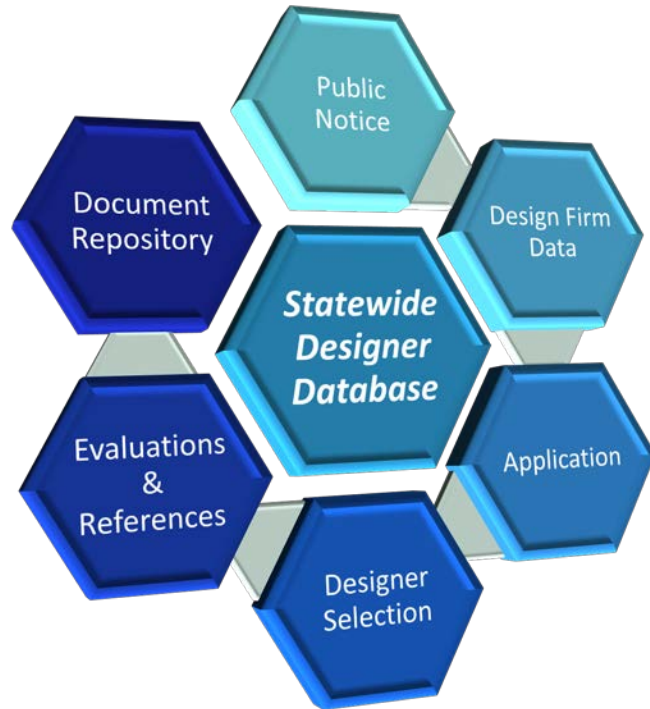
Evaluation Factors For Design Team Selection

- Provide description of specific working relationships and responsibilities amongst team
- Include members for both MBE/WBE firms and those with which they will be teaming
