### **Renew Early and Save \$10**



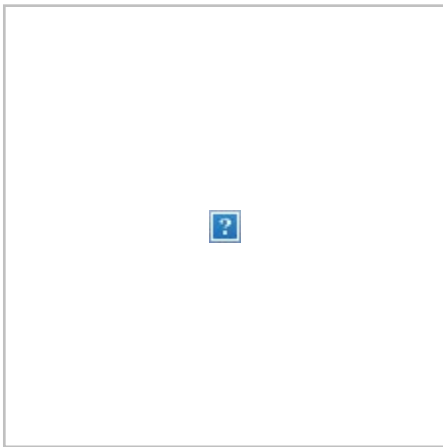

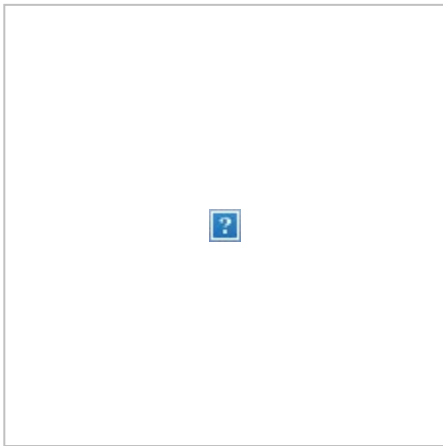

## Licensure Renewal Information and Tips

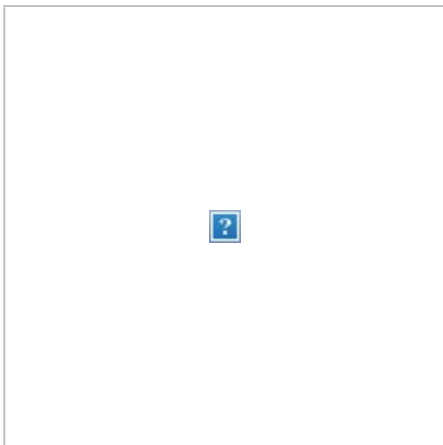

## PEs Who Haven't Responded to CE Audit Face Action

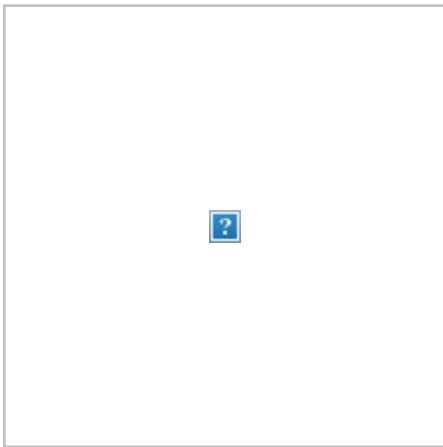

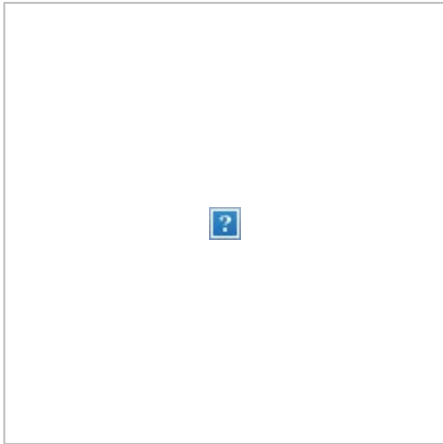

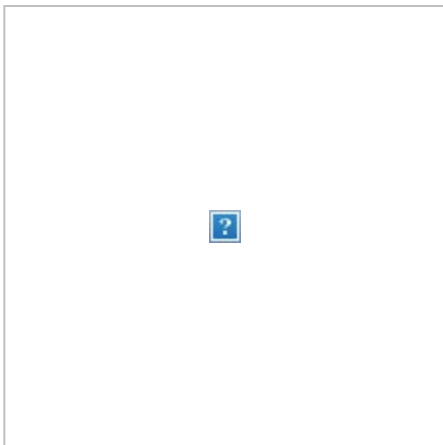

### **Legal Department: Latest Engineer Disciplinary Actions**



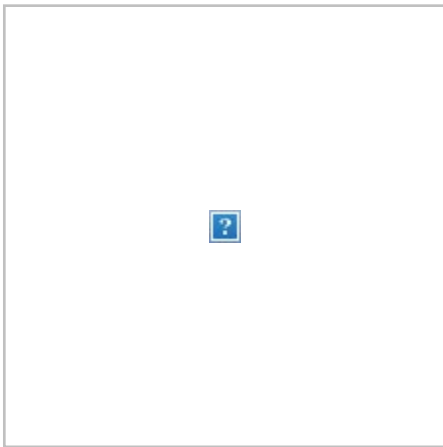

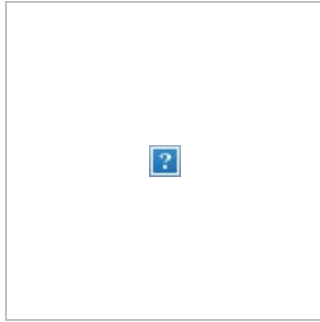
