As our profession swan-dives into the deep end of the technology pool it has been shedding many traditional tools such as plumb-bobs, steel tapes, chaining pins, and dip needles. However, a field book is a different story. Geared toward survey technicians, this webinar will identify the critical reasons that all field personnel should be carrying a traditional field book with them at all times. The speaker will also discuss the importance of putting in place a QA/QC process to make sure that all field information is captured in real time and preserved in its unedited form.

A. Richard Vannozi, MS, PLS, Assistant Professor, Surveying Engineering Technology, University of Maine

Mr. Vannozi is a graduate of the University of Maine where, in 1984, he earned a BS in Forestry and, in 2006, earned an MS in Forestry, both with a surveying emphasis. Mr. Vannozi has taught surveying across New England since 2003. Most recently, Mr. Vannozi joined the faculty of the Surveying Engineering Technology program at The University of Maine in the Fall of 2019 where he teaches courses across the curriculum both in the traditional classroom and on-line. He is registered as a Professional Land Surveyor in Massachusetts and was first

licensed in 1988 at the age of 25. He is a Past-President of the Massachusetts Association of Land Surveyors and Civil Engineers (MALSCCE) and, in 1998, was recognized as MALSCCE's Surveyor of the Year.
