IIJA Implementation



- First up:
 - Existing formula programs, e.g. State DOT highway apportionments
 - Existing discretionary grants, e.g. RAISE, INFRA, FTA capital investments

IIJA Implementation



- Slower spend-out:
 - New programs, e.g. EV charging stations, broadband deployment
 - Large discretionary programs, e.g. passenger rail

- Alternative project delivery methods
- Aligning climate goals with transportation priorities
