

- Change Order Reform:

 - Delegation of Authority
 - Automated work-flow
 - Training Staff
 - Pilot with Small Projects

A Small Project is any vertical construction project at DCAMM capable of being completed on an accelerated timeline.


Criteria:

- B. Under \$10 million Estimated Construction Cost
- C. Capable of Completion in 1 year
- D. Constitutes 70-75% (by number) of DCAMM's current portfolio




