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# Trump Admin. – Opportunities

- Infrastructure -- \$1 trillion agenda, strong relationship with new DOT Secretary
- Tax Reform international focus, vehicle for infrastructure funding/financing
- Regulatory Reform Highlights & Future "Blacklisting" Stopped, Potential FLSA changes, ACA, further environmental streamlining
- □ Energy projects pipelines, exploration



# Trump Admin. – Challenges

- Trade/International –NAFTA reassessed, focus on bi-lateral agreements
- Immigration Reform/H-1B Visas
- Climate change/sustainability
- Achieving consensus in closely divided Congress



Trump Proposed Funding— Transportation

### Overall \$2.4 billion (13%) decrease

- Budget proposal limits transit & new starts capital investment funding to projects with existing full funding grant agreements.
- Eliminates TIGER multimodal grants and support of Amtrak long distance routes
  - Refocuses funding on state-supported routes & Northeast corridor



- Trump Proposed Funding Defense & Homeland Security
- \$54B boost to defense spending with broad references to increasing milcon and hardware portfolios
- USACE reduced by \$1B 16.3% reduction from FY'16
- \$2.6B for border wall and other "tactical infrastructure" and border security technologies
- FEMA funding cut by \$667M & new 25% match for FEMA preparedness grants



### Trump Proposed Funding --EPA

- **Budget cut by \$2.6B or 31.4%**
- 4% increase for Clean Water and Drinking Water State revolving funds (\$2.3B) + \$20M for the new WIFIA program.
- \$330M reduction in the Superfund hazardous waste clean-up
- **Elimination of funding for:** 
  - Clean Power Plan
  - □ International climate change programs
  - Great Lakes Restoration Initiative
  - Chesapeake Bay restoration project



### Trump Proposed Funding – GSA & VA

- Budget increased by \$200M
  - Although not stated, GSA plays a large role on the border
  - **GSA** also exploring the sale of excess gov't property
- The VA's proposed budget is increased \$4.4B or 6% for a total of \$78.9B
  - **General Focus is on healthcare and medical facilities**
  - □Also focused on improving patient access with an increase of \$4.6B
  - **USACE** has the CM role in the \$100M+ projects



### Trump Proposed Funding – US International Programs

#### **USAID** and State

- Overall cut of 27% to both State and USAID
- Budget cut by \$400M for State Embassy Accounts
- \$650M cut from US support to World Bank and other multi-lateral development banks
- **OPIC** and USTDA slated for elimination
- Has signaled support for the Export-Import Bank





- Export-Import Bank in FAST Act; now working to secure quorum to enable the Bank to approve larger (greater than \$10 million) loan requests.
- Preferences for US firms in USAID projects Rep. Dent (R-PA) and Rep. Ruppersberger (M-MD) included language in State Department appropriations bill.
- Engaging with agencies and Congress on bi-laterative trade agreements.
- Ongoing market opportunity programs

## **Transportation** Update

- □ FAST Act: \$305 billion/10% funding increase.
- ☐ Implementation underway:
  - Two rounds of the new FASTLANE freight grant program launched, initial TIFIA loans announced last summer;
  - > Alternative finance/VMT pilot program launched;
- ACEC focused on long-term funding, working with industry partners on outreach to new Congress, Administration.
- □ FAA Reauthorization—extended through Sept. 2017
  - Increase investment
  - □ FAR cost principles to airport contracts



### Transportation Lobbying by ACEC

- Generational opportunity to address system needs and overcome funding shortfalls.
  - Congress must include a long-term, sustainable solution for the Highway Trust Fund, which will be depleted again in 2020.
- Incentivize private investment and promote U.S. engineering firms on P3 projects.
- Allocate funding through existing programs to ensure effectiveness and efficiency.
- Federal investments should be coupled with reforms to streamline reviews and permitting for infrastructure and energy projects.



### Tax Reform

□ House Tax Reform Blueprint:

- New top rates for corporations (20%), passthroughs (25%), and individuals (33%);
- Eliminates individual & corporate AMT, estate tax; full expensing for capital investments; eliminates most deductions (retains R&D).
- > Eliminates taxes on overseas income going forward.
- "Could form basis of larger reform package, fund infrastructure."
- Tax "extenders" in 2017 renewable energy, energy efficient buildings (Section 179D).
- □ IRS Denying R&D tax credit for A/E firms:

### Tax Reform Lobbying by ACEC

- Promoting Exports—U.S. is major exporter of engineering services – shifting to territorial taxation and encouraging exports is positive step.
- Protecting Employee Ownership—Congress should support employee ownership.
- Infrastructure—Opportunity for funding and financing to support President's infrastructure plan;



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
