Reports to:	Partnering Committee Chair/Co-Chairs
Purpose:	Attend, participate in and provide input at partnering committee planning meetings and, potentially in partnering committee meetings with appropriate public agency as an ACEC/MA representative.
Term:	Usually for 2 fiscal years. Appointed by ACEC/MA Comm. Co-Chairs TALC/EAC/BEC/PSC and Board Liaison, in consultation with ACEC/MA Executive Committee.
Expected Meeting Attendance:	<ul> <li>Regularly attend partnering committee planning meetings* as scheduled</li> <li>Regularly attend partnering committee meetings** as scheduled, as determined by applicable Partnering Chair/Co-chairs.</li> <li>Regularly attend associated TALC / EEAC / BEC / PSC Committee meetings (about 10/year)</li> <li>Attend ACEC/MA programs; encourage others from your firm to attend programs</li> <li>Participate in Engineers and Land Surveyors Day at the State House in May</li> <li>Attend and participate in special events and fundraisers, as needed.</li> </ul>
Obligations of the Partnering Committee Members:	<ul> <li>Employed by an ACEC/MA Member firm in good standing with dues paid for current fiscal year.</li> <li>Be familiar with current ACEC/MA bylaws, policies and procedures.</li> <li>Represent the broad interests of the ACEC/MA membership</li> <li>Visit your state representative and state senator.</li> <li>Be an advocate and a spokesperson for ACEC/MA and the Industry.</li> </ul>
Duties for the Partnering Committee Members:	<ul> <li>Duties:</li> <li>Contribute in the development of an agenda for each Partnering Committee meeting.</li> <li>Volunteer for tasks related to the partnering committee, including data gathering, writing and editing materials to be discussed at partnering meetings.</li> <li>Volunteering to take minutes at several partnering meetings each year.</li> <li>Support the ACEC Political Action Committee (national) unless corporate policy limits PAC participation.</li> <li>Support ACEC/MA in general.</li> </ul>
