Replaces the Project Information legacy system used to manage MassDOT's \$1.5 billion annual advertising program. The new system will better assist all of us in our collective goal of collaborating on and delivering great projects.



Includes schedule management capabilities for design consultants and project managers. Schedules and milestones now easily accessible for all authorized users and align with SOP templates.



Allows collaboration with the design community and agency stakeholders to improve project visibility both internally and externally. Capabilities include communications, document management, and an external user portal.



Centralized project and schedule data will allow for future reporting and analytics to support business decisions and external reporting requirements.



Built on the Salesforce & Leankor technology platform providing a configurable and scalable solution. Flexibility allows us to implement future business process changes and overall improvements faster than we can today.

Release 1 is only a starting point. Future updates will bring continuous improvements and new features.

Initial Project Migrations & Training




- At Go-Live (currently Jan-Feb 2025): 1st "Wave" of projects will be migrated to the new version
- Waves are groups of individual MassDOT Project Managers
- As each wave is released those PMs will have **ALL** of their projects migrated to the new system
- 1st Wave consists of two PMs, will scale up with each successive wave
- **New User Training:** For each Wave, MassDOT personnel (Project Controls) will train the internal PMs and reach out to Project Designers to:
 - Set up accounts, update schedules in MS Project utilizing the new templates, and learn to create schedules in the new Leankor system
 - Designer Consultants are encouraged to use new schedules ahead of migration
- When MassDOT PMs and Design Consultants are trained, and the schedule has been created in Leankor, the PMs approve the schedule and the project is considered fully migrated
- Project is managed through the new system going forward with some legacy components
- Special thanks to CDR Maguire and VHB for UAT feedback

Design Consultant Access

After Go-Live:

- External Portal will be accessible
- Design Consultants will have to assign a company Administrator
- Once accepted, they can grant their own PMs/Schedulers access through the portal
- MassDOT will work with ACEC to improve outreach and communication with Design Consultants

Future Releases



At Release 1, certain features will not yet be fully integrated into the new system:



CAPE (Contract Advertising and Planning Estimator)

-for 1st release the CAPE will be managed through the legacy system but updates to new version via sync



External Applications

-systems such as BlueBeam, MaPIT, CAPE, etc., will be fully integrated in future releases



Legacy Project Data Updates

-a few other workflows (i.e. Project Initiation) will still happen in legacy until projects are migrated or synced to the New System

This is an Interim State. All features will eventually be integrated into the new PINFO in future releases.



User Roles


-Release 1 supports only PMs and DCs, access to other users will be expanded as the product is rolled-out and enhanced


