The ACEC/MA Odyssey Leadership Program is open to ACEC /MA members and non-members. The 9-session interactive program includes an individual one-on-one coaching session. Students create a personal vision as part of the program.

Who Should Participate

Senior management, middle management and anyone who has been identified as a high potential leader. Typically, participants have 10 to 15 years of experience.

When and Where

All sessions will be held in-person at the Conference Center at Waltham Woods. Sessions will run 8-4:30 with lunch and several breaks. Instructors will schedule time for the one on one meetings with each attendee. Sessions will move to online if necessary.

Enrollment Process
